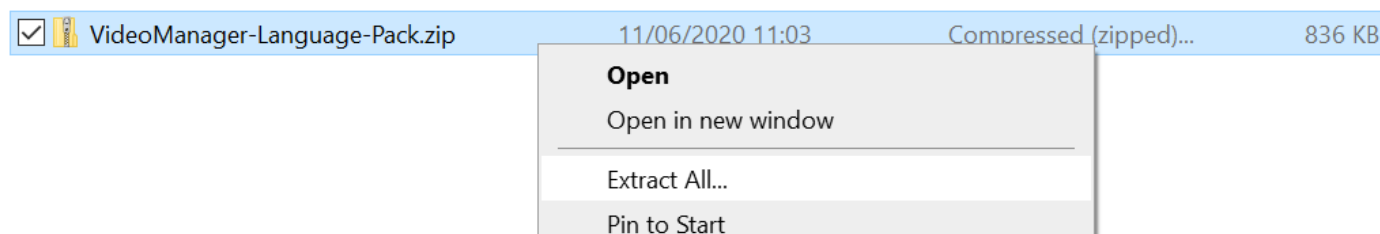
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## Extract the language file from the ZIP folder

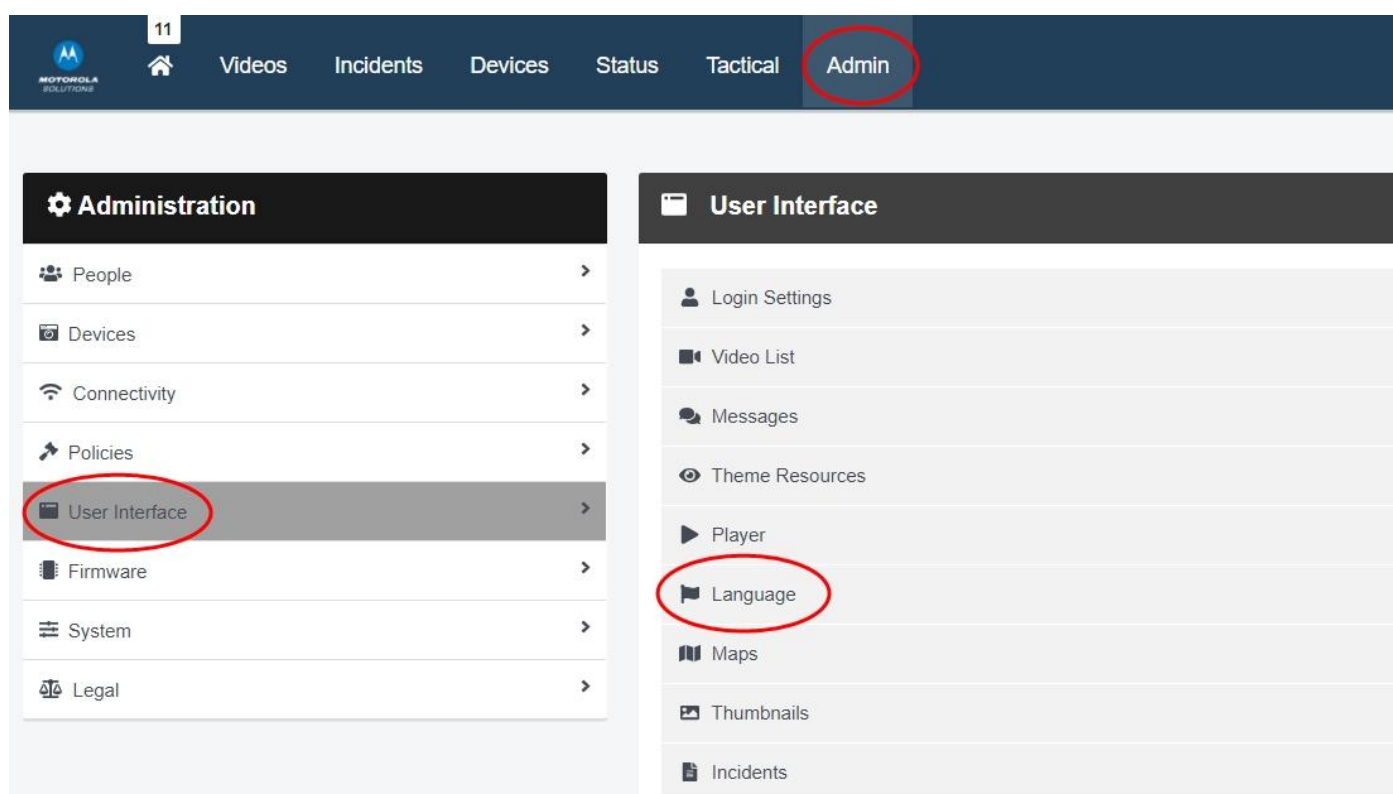
To use a VideoManager language file, you must first download the language folder and unzip it to a suitable folder on your PC. To do so, right-click on the folder and select **Extract All...**



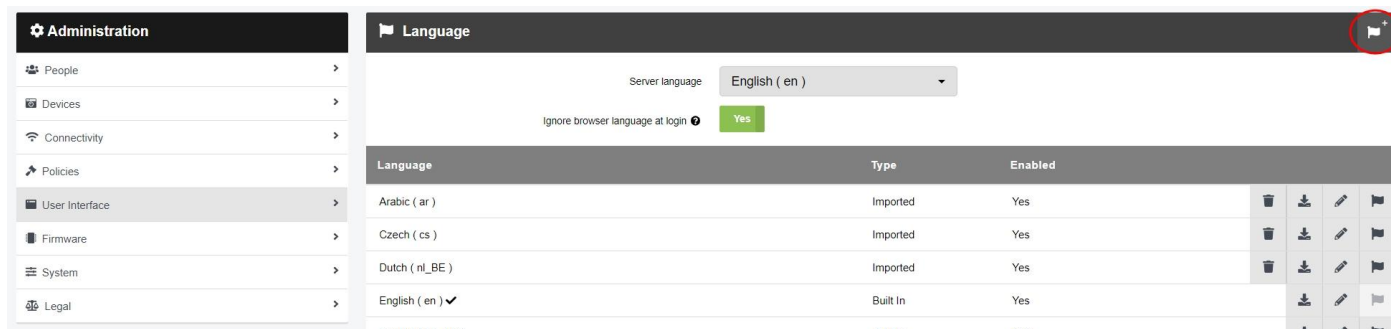
## Import the language file into VideoManager

The language file can now be imported into VideoManager. To do so:

1. On VideoManager, navigate to the **Admin** tab.
2. Select the **User Interface** pane.
3. Click the **Language** section.



4. Click **Import Language File**.



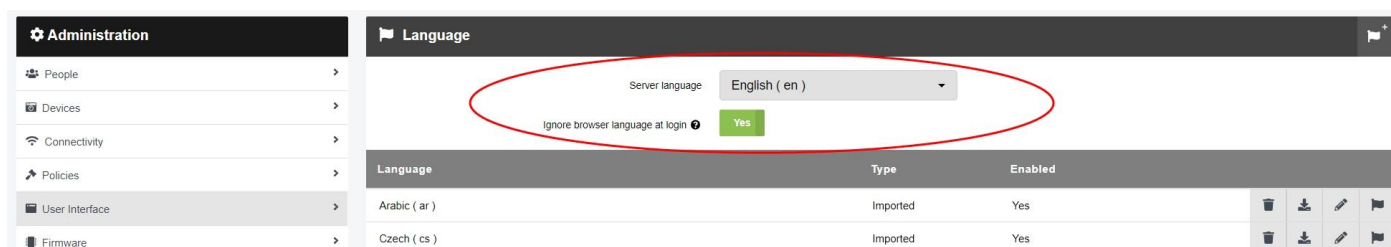
5. Click **Choose File**, and select the previously-downloaded language file.
6. Click **Import**.

If the import has been successful, the language file will appear in the **Language** section.

## Use the language file

Once the language file has been imported, you can set it as the default for all users on VideoManager. You can also determine whether VideoManager will detect and use the browser language when possible. To do so:

1. On VideoManager, navigate to the **Admin** tab.
2. Select the **User Interface** pane.
3. Click the **Language** section.
4. From the **Server Language** dropdown, select the previously-imported language file.
5. If **Ignore Browser Language at Login** is set to **Yes**, VideoManager will always use the server language file. If set to **No**, VideoManager will first detect the browser's language and use it if it is available.



6. Click **Save Settings**.
